DISTASTER PREPAREDNESS CHECK LIST

Prepare Your Pets for Travel List

- Familiarize Carriers: Leave them open with treats.
- Comfort Items: Add blankets or toys.
- Know Hiding Spots: Cats especially hide during chaos.
- Carrier Picture: Attach a photo of you with your pet.
- Temporary Solutions: Use a pillowcase if a hard carrier isn't available.

Your Pets Kit List

- Food: Several days worth in waterproof containers
- Water: Containers and bowls
- Medications: Extras in waterproof containers
- Medical/ID Documents: In a waterproof bag
- First Aid Kit: Pet-specific meds and supplies
- Sanitation Needs: Litter, bags, wipes, towels
- Comfort Items: Leashes, collars, bedding, toys.
- ID Picture: You with your pet.
- Include in Human Go Bag: Keep it ready.

Microchips provide a reliable way to identify your pet if lost. They contain vital information and must be registered and updated to work effectively.
